Pasi Kärkkäinen-Tunkelo (b. 1986) is an artist and designer who works across a wide range of materials and media. He collaborates regularly with artisans, drawing inspiration from their exquisite crafting skills. He also creates bespoke designs in collaboration with interior architects.

Featuring both utilitarian and decorative items, the works in this exhibition waver between functional form and organic shapes plucked from nature. Visitors are invited to contemplate the aesthetic context and how they might respond to individual objects were they to be transplanted in different surroundings.

The exhibits are displayed as a 'total work of art', filling the space like a rolling landscape of woodlands and lakeshores. The exhibition invites you to pause, observe, and wander in its midst. Look closely, and wondrous things will take shape before your eyes.
